Please know that MDS Nordion has taken immediate action to scale up Molybdenum-99 (Mo-99) production in response to Mallinckrodt's recently announced voluntary recall of Ultra-TechneKow® DTE Generators. MDS Nordion is working closely with our customer, Bristol-Myers Squibb Medical Imaging, to meet North American supply requirements for Mo-99 and technetium generators. MDS Nordion successfully provided the entire North American requirements for Mo-99 during a similar, previous disruption. We are confident of doing so again for as long as this unfortunate situation might last.

MDS Nordion is committed to providing a high quality and reliable supply of medical isotopes to the nuclear medicine community to enable healthcare professionals to deliver personalized medicine to their patients.

We will keep you informed as the situation evolves.
