IMRP2016 The 18th IMRP: A great success

We thank our customers for visiting Nordion at IMRP in November in Vancouver, and contributing to another successful conference. It was timely that we were able to announce a new cobalt supply during the conference:

- Bruce Power and Nordion signed a landmark contract extension that will see a stable and secure source of cobalt supply from the four Bruce B CANDU reactors to 2064. (<u>Read more</u>)
- Bruce Power signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Ontario Power Generation to share best practices around cobalt production, potentially bringing the four CANDU reactors at Darlington into Nordion's supply chain, and Bruce also announced an intention to look at additional cobalt supply from the four Bruce A reactors. - There is an active project to look at expanding Nordion's Russian supply of cobalt from RBMK reactors to two more sites.
